

## Short films

Rebecca has directed 4 short films:

- 1. Waiting for Dogot**, 2001. Dr. Who Sylvester McCoy was the narrator for her graduation film 'Waiting for Dogot'. The film was screened at Annecy, France; the Georgetown Indy film Festival, U.S.A.; and at Kino Fest Manchester, where it won **The Cosgrove Hall Award for Best Animated Short Film**, beating off competition from the Gorillaz and Aardman's Angry kid.
- 2. The Girl & the Horse**, 2003. This film was commissioned by Channel 4/AIR. It was written, animated and directed by Rebecca, and produced by Chris Shepherd at Slinky Pictures. It has been screened at numerous national and international festivals including The New York Children's Film Festival, Melbourne International Film Festival, The Edinburgh Festival, and the **British Animation Awards**, where it was **nominated for Best Music and The Public Choice Award**. In 2005 it was shown at the **National Gallery London**, as part of their 'Horses Galore' film season, in conjunction with the 'Stubbs and the Horse' exhibition.
- 3. The Big Top**, 2004. Hewlett Packard commissioned this film through agency Publicis, as part of their 'Hype' campaign. It was screened online; at the Old Truman Brewery Brick Lane and in Soho London; and at the Chinese Theatre, Hollywood, U.S.A.
- 4. Birdman**, 2004. Rebecca made this film for the quirky independent film competition 'Straight 8'. Birdman was a runner up, and was subsequently screened at The Other Cinema, as part of the **Soho Shorts festival** in 2004. (go to [www.straight8.net](http://www.straight8.net) for more details).
